COIL stands for: Collaborative Online International Learning. I first found out about COIL thanks to the GL office at FIU. After I attended their seminar and I decided to coil one of my language and culture courses. I found a University partner in Central Italy and I started with my ITA2200 students in Fall 2018.

My Italian colleague and I had several synchronous meetings via Skype for business where the Students of Italian from both Universities worked in small groups researching and sharing information regarding specific topics on Central Italy traditions, customs and cultural events.

Students mostly focused on the Eurochocolate Festival, an internationally renowned annual event that takes place in Perugia, and celebrates, and educates chocolate lovers on the making and the benefits of this food.
